

10 ways to play with sidewalk chalk!

1 || Make Your Own Sidewalk Chalk from Playful Learning

If you're a DIYer, you'll love this cool step-by-step recipe for how to make your own sidewalk chalk from Playful Learning. The process is a fun, hands-on, sensory mess – kids will love it!

2 || Make a giant maze! Use different colors to use as paths. Can you follow them even when the colors mix or cross? Don't forget to use different shaped lines: zig zags, straight, curly, curvy, etc.

3 || Practice writing your name.

4 || Play Pictionary! Can someone guess what you are drawing? Give them hints along the way.

5 || Hopscotch

6 || Tic Tac Toe

7 || Write an inspiring message!

8 || Color Hop: Draw circles in different colors close to one another. Call out colors and have your child jump on the right one. For older kids, sequence the colors: "hop from blue to green to yellow" or make it harder: "jump on green, hop on yellow, sit down on blue".

9 || Wet Chalk Art: Just dip the end of your sidewalk chalk in a bit of water and color away! This idea makes the chalk go on smooth and the colors even more bright and vibrant! Check it out!

10 || Make a self-portrait with all of the colors! Don't forget to send us a picture so we can guess who it is! :)
